



2009 SCADA North-South All-Star Football Game QUEEN SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST (Deadline November 15, 2009)

PLEASE NOTE SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THIS YEAR'S CONTEST !

1. **One candidate per school.** Each school is asked to offer applications to any interested senior girls who will be attending an institution of higher learning; then *have the school scholarship committee (or guidance counselor committee) select ONE candidate to represent your school.*
2. **No application fee.** There is no application fee. Wendy's and Wells Fargo Home Mortgage - The Millen Team are sponsoring the event.
3. **Judging criteria.** Be sure to inform prospective applicants that judges will make their initial evaluations based not on submitted photographs, but instead on the following: academic achievement, extra-curricular activities at school, community service and activities, and a brief essay. There is no talent or performance element to this competition, but noting those skills on the entry form is important information for our panel of judges to get a complete picture of each contestant.
4. **Finalists.** From all applicants, ten finalists will be selected. They and their chaperone will be our guests in Myrtle Beach on Thursday (check-in) and Friday nights prior to the SCADA North-South All-Star Football Game on Saturday, December 12, 2009. The final interview and judging will be conducted during the weekend, and the candidates will be recognized at the awards presentation ceremony, with winners announced during the halftime activities of the football game.
5. **Awards.** Three awards will be presented as scholarships to the college/university/etc. of the winners' choice: \$1,000 to the Game Queen and \$500 to each of the two Game Princesses. Scholarship payment will be paid when proof of enrollment at a college or university is provided by the winners.
6. **Attire.** No formal gowns are required for any portion of the competition. Dress for the interview session and the awards ceremony should be similar to the kind of clothing you would wear to a business interview or Sunday church. The type of clothing worn at the game on Saturday will be dictated by the weather. The presentation is very similar to homecoming presentations at high schools.
7. **GUIDANCE COUNSELORS: How to submit your school's candidate**
 - 1) **Send a completed entry form**
 - 2) **Send two (2) pictures (color or black and white, any type)**
 - 3) **Include a copy of the contestant's high school transcript**
8. **Notification.** Finalists will be notified **by e-mail** on or about November 20, 2009. Unsuccessful candidates will also receive e-mail notification. *No contestant's status will be given over the phone by the judges or from the SCADA North-South All-Star Game headquarters.*
